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HISTORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CARDIOLOGY

S.C.B MEDICAL COLLEGE ,CUTTACK

Cardiology is an important branch of general medicine. Because of its rapid growth, creation of a separate department was very much stressed by Prof.(Dr) J. P. Das, the Father of Cardiology in our state. Due to his persistent effort, Cardiology Department was created in 1969 in S.C.B Medical College College, Cuttack

First temporary and subsequently permanent pacemaker implantation was done in 1974. The period between 1976 and 1979 was remarkable because a separate cardiac catheterization laboratory with IITV started to gradually become functional. Twelve channel breccorder and cut film angiography machine were established. In year 1979 M-mode and in year 1982, 2-d with Doppler echo machines were available. These facilities at the time were only available at cuttack, that too in whole eastern India.

During the year 1998 a state of the art modern cardiac cath. Lab was established and started functioning under guidance of Dr, D.B. Tonpe. Dr Tonpe and Dr H.N Mishra and their team started doing coronary angiogram, PTCA and BMV. Soon after superannuation of Dr. Tonpe, Dr. M. Behera took charge of the deparment and carried forward the work in the cath. Under guidance of Dr. M. Behera and Dr H.N Mishra, their team increased the work in many fold which is now comparable with any advanced cardiac centre of our country. At present, we have 8 bedded I.C.C.U with ventilators facility, 3 colour Doppler machines, one holter machines and two Tread mill machines functioning in our Department. The cardiology department was shifted to the present new building in 21.11.2011 where we have 8 beded I.C.C.U with ventilators facility, 60 beds for indoor patients, 3 colour Doppler machines, one holter machines and two Tread mill machines . We are also Workshops every 4 month in which EP Study with Radiofrequency ablation , PDA Closure etc are being done

Upto 2010 we have 2 recognised D.M seats. In 2010 MCI permitted another 4 seats in cardiology making atotal of of 6 D.M seats in each batch.
